

Communication: Pairwork unit 7

Work in pairs. You are going to take it in turns to ask each other questions about the future. You must talk for 30 seconds without hesitating or repeating yourself.

Without looking at the worksheet, Student A chooses a number between 1 and 20. Student B asks him / her this question, then crosses it out. After Student A has spoken for 30 seconds, Student B chooses a different number and Student A asks him / her the question, and so on until there are no more questions.

- 8 Will you stay in contact with all your school friends after you leave school? How?
- 9 What are you going to buy with the money from your first job?
- 10 Will you learn another language after English? Why? / Why not? Which one?
- 11 If you win the lottery, what will you do with the money?
- 12 What are you doing this weekend?
- 13 If you buy a house, where will it be and what will it be like?
- 14 What job are you going to get when you leave school?
- 15 What will this school be like in 2020?
- 16 Will you have any children? How many would you like to have?
- 17 Are you and your friends planning anything exciting this year? What?
- 18 If you become famous, what will you be famous for?
- 19 Will you become a volunteer for a charity? Why? / Why not? Which one?
- 20 What are you watching on TV tonight?
