- *We dance twice a week.*
- *We don't dance twice a week.*
- *Do we dance twice a week?*

Él envía una postal a Londres.

- *He sends a postal to London.*
- *We doesn't send a postal to London.*
- *Does we sent a postal to London?*

Mis amigos estudian inglés y francés.

- *My friends study English and French.*
- *My friends don't study English and French.*
- *Do my friends study English and French?*

Vosotros leéis en casa.

- *You read at home.*
- *You don't read at home.*
- *Do you read at home?*

Los alumnos juegan con la pelota.

- *The pupils play with the ball.*
- *The pupils don't play with the ball.*
- *Do the pupils play with the ball?*



Mis abuelos compran en el supermercado.

- My grandparents buy in the supermarket.
- My grandparents don't buy in the supermarket.
- Do my grandparents buy in the supermarket?

Thomas cena a veces en el salón.

- Thomas sometimes has dinner in the living room.
- Thomas doesn't sometimes have dinner in the living room.
- Does Thomas sometimes have dinner in the living room?

La profesora habla alemán.

- The teacher speaks german
- The teacher doesn't speak german.
- Does the teacher speak german?

Helen lleva puesto una falda rosa.

- Helen wears a pink skirt.
- Helen doesn't wear a pink skirt.
- Does Helen wear a pink skirt?

Ellas van a la feria.

- She goes to the fair.
- She doesn't go to the fair.
- Does she go to the fair?

Nosotros buscamos huellas.

- We look for footprints
- We don't look for footprints.
- Do we look for footprints?

El sol brilla en el cielo azul.

- The sun shines in the blue sky.
- The sun doesn't shine in the blue sky.
- Does the sun shine in the blue sky?
